Dear Parent/Carer

We are really pleased with how students have made such a positive start in PE this term and we are very much looking forward to teaching them this year. I am writing to draw your attention to a few updates regarding lessons and also extra-curricular activities that are now in place at The Newbridge School for the new term and year ahead.

PE Kit

All students are expected to wear the full Newbridge School PE kit. Students will need to change into their kit every time they have PE and change back into their uniform at the end of the lesson.

All students are to wear The Newbridge School branded sports kit, in line with the school supplier. As follows:

- 1 pair of royal blue shorts
- 1 royal blue T-shirt
- 1 pair of royal blue football socks
- 1 royal blue training top or royal blue crew top
- Trainers for indoor and outdoor use
- Football boots that are 3G approved

Optional

- Navy tracksuit bottoms
- Royal, navy or black base layer tops and tights (for under shorts)
- Sports leggings royal, navy or black

If students fail to bring their PE kit for the lesson they will be issued with a C1, and offered PE department kit to borrow. If they then refuse to wear PE department kit then this will result in a C3 consequence.

If a student brings a letter explaining why they haven't got their kit or are unable to do the lesson (ill or injured) then, depending on the reason, they will be given the opportunity to borrow kit and participate or they will be able to sit out.

Along with the overall school policy regarding uniform and kit, all students have been told about the new policy during lessons this week. We are giving students until 12th September to allow everyone the opportunity to get the right kit. After then the sanctions will be applied.
